TREASURER'S REPORT:

Treasurer Rogan presented the Treasurer's Report, stating that currently the Association has in round numbers \$311,744 in Reserves and \$9,372 in the Operating Account. Conroy makes motion to approve Treasurers Report and Finnegan seconded. The report was approved 5-0. With fully funded Reserves, we are in a strong financial position.
